Uncertain future after PCTs

Enquiries have been made as to what impact, if any, there might be on the Barnard Medical Practice in view of the Bexley Care Trust closure. It has been confirmed that closure will be complete by the end of March. Some staff have already been made redundant while others will be retained in either the BSU (Business Support Unit) or the Sector operating team, both of which will be working alongside the GP Consortia after closure of the Primary Care Trusts. The Business Support Unit provides such functions as budgets and management plans; the Sector operating team handles contracting and would replace the corresponding staff of the PCT with a reduction in numbers.

There has been some concern over their suitability they open outwardly.
